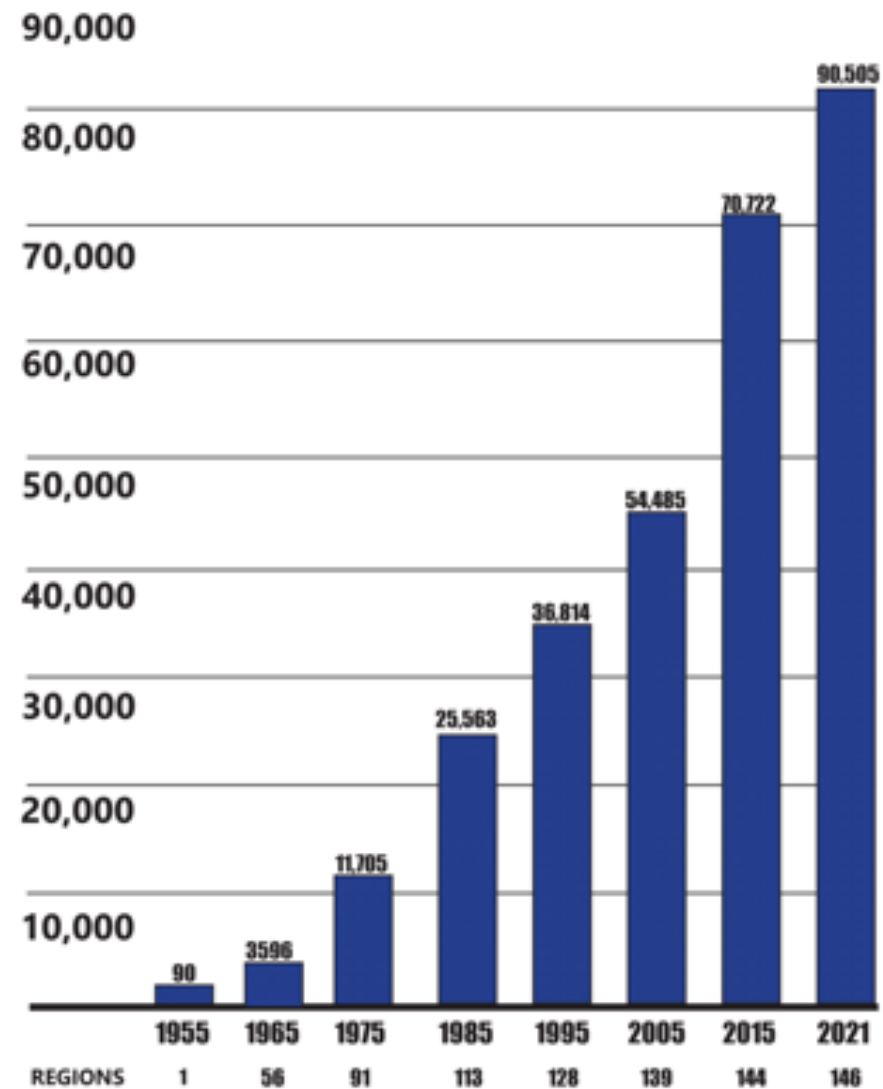

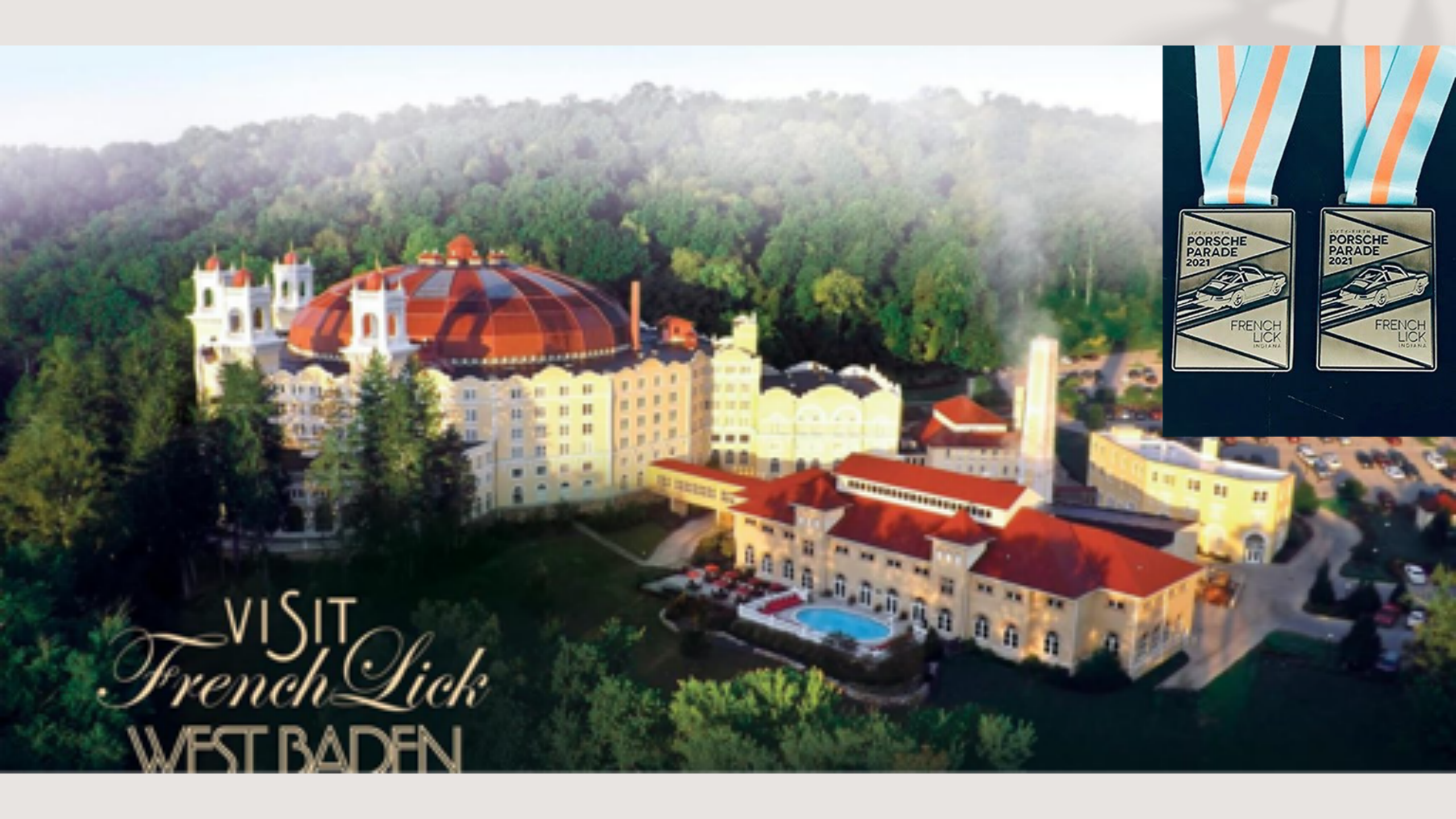

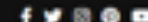

# AZPCA DRIVING TOURS

A Driving Tour is a relaxing drive (usually with a Porsche in view in front and in back of you) to an interesting destination in and around the Phoenix area, and often to further destinations around the state and beyond. Typically driven at a leisurely pace, meant to provide enjoyment with your car in the company of other Porsche owners sharing an interesting experience.



# Past driving tour destinations

- In the Valley: Bartlett Lake-Cave Creek, Scenic route to Fountain Hills
- Day drives: Prescott, Sedona, Flagstaff, Mt. Lemmon, Mingus Mountain-Jerome-Cottonwood
- Weekend Tours: Alpine, Bisbee, Winslow-La Posada
- Longer Trips: Albuquerque Balloon Fiesta; Durango, CO; Moab, UT; Southern California (Porsche Exp. Ctr./Petersen Museum)

# Driving Tour Expectations

- Drivers must be at least 18 years old, with valid driver's license.
- All persons who will be participating, *including all passengers*, must sign a PCA event waiver.
- Drivers will be expected to obey all traffic laws, including posted speed limits and traffic control provisions, during the drive.

# Driving Tour Expectations

- Car Separation: Drivers should avoid lagging far behind the car in front of them, to ensure group integrity. *But under no circumstances should drivers take unsafe or unnecessary measures to do so. In particular, speeding through a yellow or red traffic signal in order to keep up with the group is not acceptable.*



# Driver Conduct

- *Failure to follow procedures detailed above, unsafe driving, blatant disregard of traffic laws, passing unsafely, and putting others in danger are reasons to exclude a participant from a tour. Should the AZPCA Board of Directors deem that a member's behavior violates PCA or Arizona Region rules and requirements for participation in events, the Board of Directors may impose sanctions, including but not limited to restricting the member's participation in future events.*

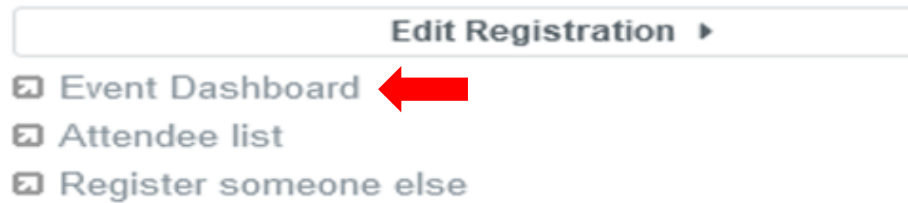

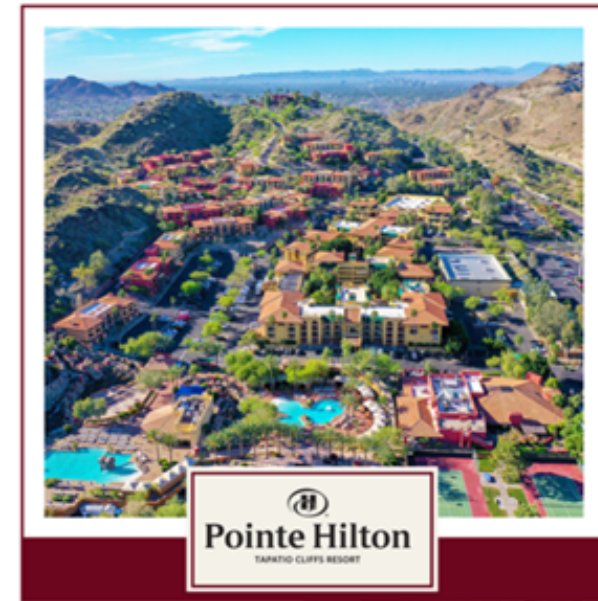

# Scoring Criteria

Each Judged Area has a default maximum score

(Detail & Shine 130 – 70 Ext, 60 Int)

(Full Vintage 325 - 70 Ext, 60 Int, 45 Storage, 65 Engine Compartment, 40 Chassis w/o engine, 45 Chassis w/engine)

Points are deducted based on any observed defect

Score is calculated by Max Points – Deducted Points

Judging is 5 minutes per car, judge per area

If one or more cars have the same score in that Division, joint prize will be presented

## First Timer- what is going to happen?

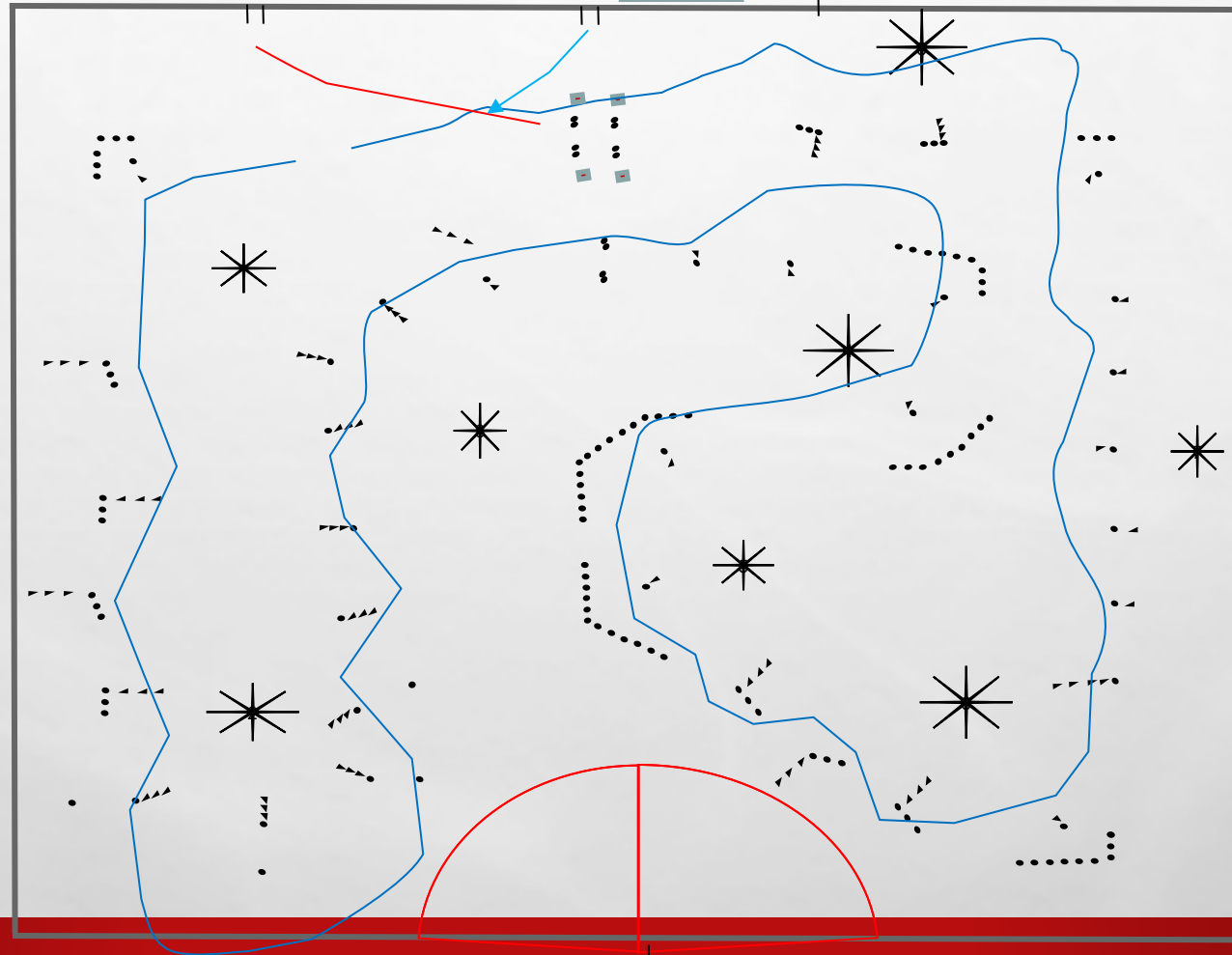

☐ **Head and Neck Restraint (HANS):** Required with harnesses.  
☐ **Structural Integrity:** no loose bolts or interior parts, no structural rust at or near suspension points.  
☐ **Doors:** must be operational from inside and outside.
